


I bought a model year 2010 car prior to August 1, 2010 and received a New Car Inspection Decal for four (4) years. Why didn't my car get a five (5) year decal?

Since the law just went into effect on August 1, 2010, you were not eligible for five (5) year inspection decal when you purchased your car. However, if you purchased a car less than five model years old including 2010 between TBD 2006 and TBD 2010, your car qualifies to receive an additional one (1) year extension. Owners of these vehicles will received a **"1-YEAR EXTENSION"** Inspection Decal in the mail during the summer of 2010.

Instructions for Applying Inspection Extension Decal for New Vehicles

The extension decal attached to this card is to be applied to the inside windshield of your vehicle. Recent legislation has extended the initial inspection period from four to five years for new vehicles. The Commission records indicate that your vehicle is eligible for an additional one year inspection extension.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO RENEW YOUR VEHICLE REGISTRATION EACH YEAR.


1. Clean surface thoroughly. Decal will not stick if wet or dirty.
2. Tear along dotted line, peel top liner at the slit and place decal above current new vehicle decal.

What if a car less than five (5) model years old is purchased from someone other than a New Jersey New Car Dealer and has never inspected in the State of New Jersey, when does my car have to be inspected?

Any car less than five (5) model years is eligible for a five (5) exemption which means that it can receive a New Car Dealer Inspection Decal expiring on the last day of the month which the car was registered 5 years from the model year. You should have received a green card or SS-19 from a MVC Motor Vehicle Agency at the time of registration.

**INSPECTION DECAL REPLACEMENT FOR VEHICLES LESS THAN 5 YEARS OLD
FOR USED VEHICLES BEING REGISTERED IN NJ WITHOUT A VALID INSPECTION DECAL**

Unless otherwise required by law, vehicles are not required to be inspected until they are 5 model years old. Upon registration, the vehicle will receive an inspection decal, at an official inspection facility, expiring on the last day of the month in which it was registered 5 years from the model year. The vehicle indicated below * must be presented at a designated area of an official state inspection facility within 14 days of this notice to receive a motor vehicle inspection approval decal. The operator must have a valid driver license, current registration, and proof of New Jersey approved insurance upon arrival.

The SS19 instructs you go to designated re-inspection area of your locate state station inspection with your car to receive a New Car Dealer Inspection Decal. At the station you must present to the inspector your driver license, vehicle registration and insurance card. All documents must be originals, no copies, faxes or computer generated pdf files. After reviewing the documents, the inspector will install a New Car Dealer Inspection Decal expiring on the last day of the month which the car was registered 5 years from the model year.
